

# **WP Scanware User Guide**

## Settings – Configuring the Cron

In order to receive automated email notifications, WP RevenueCast requires a CRON job setup in your hosting account. Enter your email address on the settings screen, and use the Cron Command to create a Cron job in your hosting account.

## Dashboard – Managing your files

WP Scanware will automatically scan all files in your WordPress installation each time the dashboard is loaded. You will be able to see a listing of all files that are 'possible' threats.

Files are identified based on certain criteria as flagged in the 'Issue' column. Not all files are threats. For example many plugin developers will obfuscate (hide by encoding) their code. You will need to use your judgement to determine if the file is a possible malicious file. If you determine the file is legitimate, then you can click to blue checkbox icon to whitelist the file.

If you determine the file is malicious, you can delete it directly within WP Scanware by clicking the red Delete icon. **It's always a good idea to check the file directly from your server, as hackers will sometimes inject malicious code directly into a valid WordPress file. Deleting the file entirely may cause fatal errors on your website.**
